


IMO S Beginners' User Guide


How to insert the SIM card?


Unclip the back cover from the bottom right hand corner of the phone. IMO S uses a Micro SIM card. Insert the SIM in the SIM 1 slot being careful to do this as shown on the image above the slot.

How to use the “Soft Keys”

Your soft keys are the 3 symbols located on the bottom of the screen.


The  symbol in the middle is your “Home” key. By touching this symbol you will instantly return to your home screen. This is your default screen which you can customise as and when you like with your favourite apps.

The  symbol on the right is your “Back” key. This will take you back 1 level each time you touch it. So if you press the wrong thing don't worry simply touch the back key and you should return to where you were!

The  symbol on the left is your “menu” key. By touching this it will show all your recently used applications and functions in windows that you can simply scroll through and select. It's basically a quicker way to access your most used apps.

How to connect to WiFi?

As you set up your new phone it should take you through the simple steps of how to set up your WiFi connection.

Alternatively to turn on WiFi touch your “apps tray” symbol . Scroll through to your “Settings” symbol and touch to open. Select WiFi from the menu and then turn “ON” in the right corner of the screen. Then select the Wi-Fi network you want to connect to and enter the “password”. This will be your own personal WiFi network password at home, or one which is exclusive to the network where you are. Eg. in a Starbucks coffee shop.

How to Sign in or create a new Google account?

To get the most of out of IMO S, you will need to sign in or create a Google account, so you can download applications, music, and games, use cool stuff like Google maps and back up and keep secure your personal contacts and content. If you skipped this step during your initial IMO S set-up, go to the Gmail app in your app tray and select Add an email address, and then follow the instructions to sign

in or create your new Google account.

How to extend your battery life?

Although your screen looks the best at full brightness, it's the biggest drain on your battery. To optimise battery life you can turn on "Adaptive brightness" by going into the Settings menu and selecting "Display". Adaptive brightness can be turned on and off here which will help extend your phones battery so you never miss a call.

Also in the Display settings look at your "Sleep" settings. You can choose the length of time your screen stays on when you're not using it before it goes to sleep. We advise around 30 seconds but it's entirely up to you.

How to take a screenshot on IMO S?

Simply hold down the power key and volume down key simultaneously and you'll get a screenshot of whatever is on your screen.

Screenshots are stored in your "gallery" in their own folder where you can share from via email, text, Facebook etc

How to transfer files / photos from your IMO S to your PC.

Please follow the steps below:

- Connect your IMO S and computer with USB cable supplied
- You will find the IMO S icon under My Computer on your PC
- From here you can drag and drop or copy and paste your pictures from your phone to your PC

How to keep your IMO S up to date?

Software updates can often improve your phones performance.

We recommend you regularly check to make sure your phone is up to date. When you update your phones software don't worry about losing any of your information or things changing. Everything will look exactly the same! Things will just run a bit more smoothly and you may get a few additional functions for free!

To check for updates go to Settings > About phone > System Upgrade > Online Update and select.
